

Printing Instructions:

1. The printing and lamination can be done at most local print shops on a color roll printer.
2. Take "Mars Challenge Drive Mat.pdf" and the "Rover 10 cm Grid.pdf" to print shop on a memory stick.
3. Print each .pdf file as 36" x 36" with no border. Print must be these exact dimensions to maintain the Rover grid scale.
4. Optionally, both files can be printed on opposite sides of the same print to produce a final double-sided drive mat.
5. The final print should be laminated with a gloss finish plastic on both sides. This durable lamination allows users to draw on the mat with a dry erase maker and then wipe off. Note - be sure to erase the mat well after each use. Dry erase marks will stain the mat if left on the laminated surface for an extended period of time.
6. It may be handy to store the print in a 38"x3" poster travel tube.
